Lauren Wallick earned her Bachelor's of Music degree in music education at Middle Tennessee State University and was inducted into the National Music Honor Society Pi Kappa Lambda in 2007. Currently, she is the music specialist and choir director at Blackman Middle School.

During her three years at BMS, students from the choir program have been selected for Tennessee Treble Honor Choir and the Middle Tennessee Vocal Association's Middle School Honor Choir. Beyond teaching music and choir, Ms. Wallick has also taught dance for several years in the area.

Randal Box is in his twentieth year as Director of Bands at Brentwood High School in Brentwood, TN. Prior to Brentwood High School, he was the band director in Pocahontas, AR, and in Clarksville, TN.

Mr. Box conducts the Wind Ensemble and the Concert Band, directs the Jazz Band, Percussion Ensemble and Marching Band, and he teaches Advanced Placement Music Theory. During his tenure, the Brentwood Band has performed for the MENC Convention in Nashville in 2002 as well as the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade in 1995 and 2001. In 2007 the Brentwood Marching Band was featured on country superstar Brad Paisley's hit record "Online" and performed with Paisley on the CMA Awards. He has conducted workshops and clinics in TN, AL, and GA, and is the author and publisher of *Flashtrax*, a DVD-based rhythmic reading instructional method.

Mr. Box is an elected member of Phi Beta Mu National School Bandmaster Fraternity and holds membership in TN Music Educators Association, Music Educators National Conference, TN Bandmasters Association, National Band Association, American School Band Directors Association, and he is currently serving as the President of Middle TN School Band and Orchestra Association. He has been named four times to Who's Who Among America's Teachers, was the Williamson County Teacher of the Year for the 2000-2001 school year, and was recognized in the December 2000 issue of *School Band and Orchestra* report "Fifty Directors Who Make a Difference". In July of 2008, Mr. Box was featured in the cover article of *The Instrumentalist*, nationally recognized as the foremost professional journal for instrumental music education.

Mr. Box was named as one of the music directors of The TN Ambassadors of Music in 2002. He has conducted this group on four European concert tours, visiting 7 countries and presenting five band and five choir concerts for European audiences in the summers of 2003, 2005, 2007 and 2009.
